

March 22, 2010

The City Council met in its regular scheduled meeting on March 22, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Brookshire and following councilmen were present: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson. Dale Hurst, Buddy Hathcock, and Bobby Johnson, Jr. were also present.

A motion was made by Henline seconded by Simpson to approve the minutes of the March 8, 2010 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

Mayor Brookshire asked if anyone had comments regarding an item/items on the agenda.

The Mayor and City Council discussed the recent TVA determination regarding commercial marina easement. After discussion a motion was made by Aikens seconded by Henline to add agenda item #1 to vote on the TVA Application on the March 22, 2010 agenda. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Aikens seconded by Henline to withdraw the City's application from TVA for the commercial marina easement. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Simpson seconded by Hines to post-pone a decision until the next council meeting and have the City Attorney look over ordinance and make a recommendation regarding an ordinance to erect a three-way stop at the intersection of Yosemite and Biscayne Roads in Harrison Woods subdivision. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Hines seconded by Johnson to award the Landscaping Contract to Superior Landscapes, Inc. with the lowest bid of \$5,970.00. The other bids are as followed: Lasting Impressions Lawn Care: \$9,168.00, Precision Landscapes \$9,388.00, Thomas Complete Lawn Care \$8,400.00, Vineyard Lawn Care \$10,680.00, Brewster \$18,000.00, Allen Tarwater \$7,840.00, and Love Grounds Maintenance \$12,480.00. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Hines seconded by Johnson to approve an agreement between City and E-911 regarding assistance with City's MS4 Storm water Management Program. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Aikens seconded by Johnson to adopt a resolution requesting consideration by the Tennessee Department of Transportation to incorporate bicycle and pedestrian facilities on the Highway 321/ Fort Loudoun Bridge over the Tennessee River in Loudon County, Tennessee. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**. **Resolution- 2010-3-22-1888.**

A motion was made by Aikens seconded by Simpson to hire Emily Lawson to fill a position in the Lenoir City Police Department. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Johnson seconded by Aikens to hire David Hodge and Joey Brookshire to fill the positions in the Lenoir City Fire Department. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Johnson seconded by Henline to approve the first reading of an ordinance providing for Plan of Services for approximately 6.3 acres of property, referenced by Loudon County Tax Map 15, Parcel 359.00. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**. **First Reading.**

A motion was made by Henline seconded by Aikens to approve the first reading of an Ordinance Annexing and zoning approximately 6.3 acres of property, referenced by Loudon County Tax Map 15. Parcel 359.00. (Property located 464 Robinson Drive). The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**. **First Reading.**

Mayor Brookshire asked for comments from citizens regarding item/items not on the agenda.

A motion was made by Hamby and seconded by Aikens to approve all bills and accounts to be paid when properly approved and funds available. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Hines to adjourn the March 22, 2010 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.
