City Council met in a Public Hearing on May 23, 2011 at 6:45 P.M. The Public Hearing was for an Ordinance providing a Plan of Services for certain territory proposed for annexation into the City of Lenoir City pursuant to §6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated, with said territory being approximately 3.2 total miles of Interstate 75 Right-of-Way. City Council met in a Public Hearing on May 23, 2011 at 6:50 P.M. The Public Hearing was for an Ordinance to annex certain Right-of-Way into the City of Lenoir City, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated §13-7-201 through §13-7-205 and §6-51-102, with said territory being approximately 3.2 total miles of Interstate 75 Right-of-Way. Following the Public Hearings, City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting at 7:00 P.M. Mayor Aikens and the following Councilmen were present: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler. Dale Hurst, Jim Wilburn, and James K. Scott were also present.

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Wampler to approve the minutes of the May 9, 2011 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Hines to approve the Second and Final Reading of an Ordinance providing a Plan of Services for certain territory proposed for annexation into the City of Lenoir City pursuant §6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated, with said territory being approximately 3.2 total miles of Interstate 75 Right-of-Way. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

**Second and Final Reading. Ordinance 2011-5-23-1935B.**

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Henline to approve closure of one (1) account for Industrial Park at First National Bank. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Shields to approve closure of one (1) account for Parks and Recreation Swimming Pool at First National Bank. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Hines to approve Recreation Advisory Board's recommendation (approval) regarding fee waiver request for use of the War Memorial Building on Friday, June 10, 2011. The facility will be used for a benefit spaghetti dinner for an ill resident of Lenoir City. The proceeds for the dinner will go towards medical bills. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Johnson to approve the “going out to bid” for annual paving contract. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.

A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Simpson to approve all bills and accounts to be paid when properly approved and funds available. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Shields to adjourn the May 23, 2011 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**. Johnson voting **NO**.
