City Council met in a Public Hearing on May 9, 2011 at 6:45 P.M. The Public Hearing was for an Ordinance adding Drought Management Plan to Title 18 of the Lenoir City Municipal Code regulating the use of water by customers of the City of Lenoir City Water System during periods of shortage of the water supply, and providing penalties for violations of these regulations. City Council met in a Public Hearing on May 9, 2011 at 6:55 P.M. The Public Hearing was for an Ordinance levying a Litigation Tax for the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee. Following the Public Hearings, City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting at 7:00 P.M. Mayor Aikens and the following Councilmen were present: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler. Dale Hurst, Jim Wilburn, and James K. Scott were also present.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Shields to approve the minutes of the April 25, 2011 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Simpson to approve the Second and Final Reading of an Ordinance adding Drought Management Plan to Title 18 of the Lenoir City Municipal Code regulating the use of water by customers of the City of Lenoir City Water System during periods of shortage of the water supply, and providing penalties for violations of these regulations. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

Second and Final Reading. Ordinance 2011-5-9-1933A.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Hines to approve Second and Final Reading of an Ordinance levying a Litigation Tax for the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

Second and Final Reading. Ordinance 2011-5-9-1933B.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Hines to approve Planning Commission's recommendation regarding the first reading of an Ordinance providing a Plan of Services for certain territory proposed for annexation in the City of Lenoir City pursuant to §6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated, with said territory being approximately 3.2 total miles of Interstate 75 Right-of-Way. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Shields to approve Planning Commission's recommendation regarding the first reading of an Ordinance to annex certain Right-of-Way into the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated §13-7-201 through §13-7-205 and §6-51-102, with said territory being approximately 3.2 total miles of Interstate 75 Right-of-Way. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Johnson to approve the installation of street lighting located at Jan Way Drive in Lenoir City, Tennessee. There are a total of two (2) lights to be installed at \$300 each; the City of Lenoir City will fund one (1) and the residents of Emerald Villas will fund one (1). The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Hines to approve Personnel Committee's recommendation regarding adding the City Attorney position to City of Lenoir City's Health Insurance Plan, adding the position as a new Employee Class within the policy. The City Attorney will pay 20% of the total monthly premium. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Shields to approve Personnel Committee's recommendation regarding filling vacant position in Police Department. The person filling the position is Officer Keith Sennett. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.

A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Shields to approve all bills and accounts to be paid when properly approved and funds available. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Hines to adjourn the May 9, 2011 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**. Johnson voting **NO**.
