A motion was made by Johnson seconded by Henline to approve the minutes of the, August 24, 2009 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

Mayor Brookshire presented a proclamation to the Daughters of The American Revolution (DAR) for Constitution Week September 17-23 2009.

The Fire, Police, Codes, Courts, Streets, and Park and Recreation presented their monthly reports to the Mayor and City Council.

Mayor Brookshire asked if anyone had comments regarding the items on the agenda

A motion was made by Aikens seconded by Johnson to approve the purchase of a used chip truck for the Street Department for the total amount of \$14,435.00. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Simpson seconded by Aikens to award the purchase of a Thermal Pool Cover to Duffield Aquatics with the only bid of \$14,908.84. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Johnson voted **NO**.

Motion carried 5-1.
