The City Council met in its regular scheduled meeting on September 28, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Brookshire and following councilmen were present: Aikens, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson. Dale Hurst, Shannon Littleton, and Bobby Johnson Jr. were also present. Councilman Hamby was not present.

A motion was made by Aikens seconded by Johnson to approve the minutes of the September 14, 2009 meeting with the change of adding Fire and Street Department Vehicles to surplus property. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**. **Hamby Absent.**

Mayor Brookshire asked if anyone had comments regarding the items on the agenda

A motion was made by Henline seconded by Johnson to add item #5 to the September 28, 2009 agenda. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**. **Hamby Absent.**

A motion was made by Johnson to adopt a resolution to prohibit handguns in certain public municipal parks and other similar public places. **Motion fails lack of Second.** The City of Lenoir City will be following the Tennessee State Law which allows handguns in parks.

A motion was made by Henline seconded by Johnson to purchase of a 2004 Freight Liner Sprint Van using funds from the DEA fund in the amount of \$11,600.00. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**. **Hamby Absent.**

A motion was made by Hines seconded by Simpson to award Pine Environmental with the lowest bid of \$4323.00 for the purchase of Photo Ionization Detectors, Single Gas Meters, and Combustible Gas Detectors for the Fire Department. The other bids are as followed: Airgas- \$6152.88, G&C- \$7863.49, Nafeco-\$7621.00, Hagemeyer- \$9670.00 and Scientific Sales- \$9676.00. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**. **Hamby Absent.**

A motion was made by Simpson seconded by Henline to authorize the City Recorder, Bobby Johnson Jr. to close the HRA United Healthcare Account at First National Bank. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**. **Hamby Absent.**

A motion was made by Aikens seconded by Johnson to close First Avenue from C to D Street for the Calvary Baptist Church Halloween Party from 4:00 p.m.- 8:30 p.m. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**. **Hamby Absent.**

Mayor Brookshire asked for comments from citizens regarding an item not on the agenda.

A motion was made by Aikens seconded by Henline to approve all bills and accounts to be paid when properly approved and funds available. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**. **Hamby Absent.**
