The City Council met in its regular scheduled meeting at 7:00 P.M. Mayor Brookshire and the following Councilmen were present: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson. Dale Hurst, Buddy Hathcock, and Bobby Johnson, Jr. were also present.

A motion was made by Aikens and seconded by Johnson to approve the minutes of the April 12, 2010 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

Mayor Brookshire asked if anyone had comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

A motion was made by Aikens and seconded by Hamby to approve the first reading of an Ordinance establishing two (2) Handicapped Parking Spaces for the Good Samaritan Center. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE. First Reading.**

A motion was made by Aikens and seconded by Henline to approve of requesting/instructing the Planning Commission to begin work in exploring the feasibility of accepting/effecting repairs to Pinewood Drive. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Aikens and seconded by Johnson to award 2009-2010 Paving Contract to Rogers Group, Incorporated with the lowest bid of \$77,472.50. The other bids are as followed: APAC-Atlantic→\$79,920.00, and Greenback Asphalt Paving→\$84,094.40. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Hines to approve of the “going out for bids” for construction of facility for Street/Sanitation Department. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

Mayor Brookshire asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.

A motion was made by Hamby and seconded by Aikens to approve of all bills and accounts to be paid when properly approved and funds available. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Simpson to adjourn the April 26, 2010 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, and Simpson voting **AYE**; Johnson voting **NO**.
